




The Cost of Diabetes Care



The Rising Cost of Care for Diabetes

Average Direct Costs of Diabetes Care

Hospital Inpatient Care



\$4,966 annually for people with diabetes, **\$2,819** is directly attributable to diabetes

Prescription Drugs and Antidiabetes Supplies



\$6,325 annually for people with diabetes, **\$4,333** is directly attributable to diabetes

Physician Office Visits



\$2,099 annually for people with diabetes, **\$1,213** is directly attributable to diabetes

Other Expenditures




\$3,364 annually for people with diabetes, **\$1,236** is directly attributable to diabetes

Total Indirect Costs Attributable to Diabetes in the U.S.: **\$89.9 Billion**

Outpatient Medications and Supplies Specific to Individuals with Diabetes

Average annual expenditures per person with diabetes: **\$6,325**

Insulin

Insulin costs an average of **\$606** annually, with significant variability relating to formulary, insurance, and list price modifications



Antidiabetes Agents and Supplies

Antidiabetes agents and supplies cost an average of **\$978** annually



Prescription Medications

Prescription medications used in the treatment of complications associated with diabetes or for other reasons cost an average of **\$4,741** annually
