Public Input

The ICC agenda includes virtual and/or in person meeting instructions, including when public comment will be taken. The public comment section occurs twice per meeting and gives individuals an opportunity to share their opinion or information. Public attendees can attend and observe as well.

How do I attend?

Meetings are open to the public and interested individuals, especially parents, are encouraged to share their opinion or information during the open public comment period or may come to observe. Your ideas and input are greatly needed to improve Early Intervention Services.
